


1. Minutes from 2/10/20 meeting were approved

3. <u>Update on Teacher Based Team Work</u> : The bi-weekly TBT meetings are going very well. Teachers are beginning to integrate the wording in the "I can" and "we" statements that are displayed on posters throughout the school. Meetings regarding standards are continuing with Cindy Eldridge; science is done, social studies is on its way and math will follow.		
4. <u>IXL Progress Monitoring Program Update</u> : Matt Eberle and Natalie Felty attended a conference the day before the school closure, but were disappointed that although they learned a few new helpful tips, the conference mostly covered the basics. They will seek other ways to learn to use the extra "bells and whistles" they hoped to learn at the conference.		
5. <u>Update on New Graduation Requirement</u> : The state has exempted graduating seniors from the consequences of end of course testing, and will lean on the 20 credit requirement as well as documentation from schools to support graduation decisions. Heather will continue to work with administration from OCS and OA to assure OCS is in compliance.		
6. <u>Other</u> : Heather filled the committee in on how the school and staff are responding to the Covid19 implications for the school. They were able to spend several days before school buildings closed to see that educational services were well organized and they were able to "hit the ground running." This included reorganizing days when subjects are taught, providing technology tools as needed, arranging individual instructional sessions, creating a system for tracking and logging communication, providing study sessions sign ups as needed, and even facilitating a student events page to help students stay socially engaged.
